By-law 144-05

**BEING A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CARMACKS IN THE YUKON
TERRITORY TO CLOSE A MUNICIPAL HIGHWAY**

WHEREAS the Council desires to permanently close a portion of municipal highway abutting Lots 12-3 and 12-4, Plan 25914 Group 903; and

WHEREAS Section 276 of the Municipal Act 1999, being Chapter 119 of the Revised Statutes of the Yukon and amendments thereto, requires that Council act by by-law to close a municipal highway; and

WHEREAS notice has been posted that a public hearing be held prior to final passage of a municipal highway closure by-law, and that such meeting was duly held ; and

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Carmacks in an open meeting duly assembled enacts as follows:

Section 1 Short Title

1.1 This by-law may be known as the “Nansen Municipal Highway Closure By-law 2005”.

Section 2 General Provisions

2.1 The map of the highway abutting the northeast boundaries of Lots 12-3 and 12-4, Plan 25914, shall be amended to exclude a 1.5 meter wide parcel, from the southeast corner of Lot 12-4 to the northeast corner of Lot 12-3, said parcel to be surveyed and a separate title provided.

2.2 The portion of municipal highway closed shall hereafter constitute the new lot noted in Section 2.1.

2.3 A public hearing was advertised then held on the day of , 2005 to allow for public intervention, discussion and review of written submissions, immediately preceding the regular meeting of council.

Section 3 Enactment

3.2 This by-law shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
