NEW AND UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. Public Input into the College Campus Issue

222/04 M/S Harris/Bellmore that whereas the proposed physical connection of the Yukon College campus to the Tantalus School has resulted in much community contention, and whereas Section 150(1) of the *Municipal Act* allows that the Council may by bylaw provide for a plebiscite to obtain the public's opinion on a matter over which the municipality has jurisdiction, that prior to giving formal endorsement to the Government of Yukon's proposal, the Village of Carmacks have a plebiscite vote to ensure there is sufficient community support for said proposal. (Note: Referred to November 8 by Motion 224/04)

223/04 M/S/C Wyatt/Hansen that motion 222/04 be tabled.

A short recess was called during discussion of Motion 223/04 and applicable sections of the *Municipal Act* and Council Procedure Bylaw were consulted. Council agreed that a "motion to refer" under Section 56 of the Procedure Bylaw would be in order should the motion to table be defeated.
